

Terms and Conditions

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENTS: Deposit is due at time of booking. Final payment is due 30 days prior to departure. Reservations made within 90 days prior to departure must be paid in full at the time of booking, and are subject to airfare price and availability.

CANCELLATION FEES: 60 days or more before departure—Loss of \$100 deposit per person. **30-60 days before departure**—Loss of \$100 deposit per person, plus all expenses associated with purchase of airfare. Airline ticket will have been purchased in your name, and will be returned to you. Eligibility for airfare voucher is subject to the rules of the carrier, and all such arrangements will be your responsibility. **1-30 days before departure**—50% of additional program cost (after airfare), in addition to provisions listed above. **Day of departure or after**—100% of program cost per person and insurance premium.

ITINERARY CHANGES: As tour arrangements are made far in advance and unforeseen circumstances may require last minute adjustments, we reserve the right to change the itinerary for any reason at any time.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: You must ensure that prior to the start of your flight, you possess a valid passport and all relevant visas and/or entry permits appropriate to all countries you will be connecting through or visiting.

INCLUSIONS: Included in the price of the trip are: Round-trip airfare from San Francisco International Airport, connecting flights and ferries, local accommodations and daily yoga instruction.

EXCLUSIONS: Not included in the price of the trip are expenditures for items not listed above as well as, but not limited to, all food on the trip, excess baggage charges, visas (at present no visas are necessary), optional entertainment or excursions, and all personal items such as telephone calls, laundry expenses, individual room service requests, in-room mini-bars, and additional travel insurance.

TRIP INSURANCE: We strongly recommend that you purchase the optional Trip Cancellation and Trip interruption coverage, which protects your travel investment if you have to cancel or interrupt your trip. You may call Travel Insured International at 1(800) 243-3174 for more information.

TRIP MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY: Trip members have a responsibility to select a trip appropriate to their abilities and interest and for being in sufficient good health to undertake the trip. By sending us your deposit, you certify that you do not have any physical condition or disability that would create a hazard for operation of the trip or the welfare or enjoyment of fellow trip members.

RELEASE AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISKS: By signing the trip application, you represent to Yoga Loka Inc. that you have read all of this section and agree to it. Please read this carefully. Any trip involving yoga, hiking, swimming, indeed any trip at all entails risks. These include, but are not limited to, loss of or damage to personal property, and injury or fatality to you, falling or tripping, drowning, exposures to temperature extremes or inclement weather, hypothermia or heatstroke, illness, food poisoning, lack of medical care, or negligent or even intentional criminal acts by others. You voluntarily assume all risks, known and unknown, of traveling. You agree to hold harmless and indemnify Yoga Loka from any and all liability, actions, claims, demands, and debts which may arise out of any events during your trip, now foreseen or unforeseen, including any claimed negligence on its part, arising out of or during your travel with it. You do so on behalf or yourself, your heirs and executors, and all members of your family, including any minors accompanying you. Yoga Loka acts only as an agent for you in arranging for certain transportation and lodging on this trip. You agree that (1) you will not claim that Yoga Loka is a common carrier on any agent for one; and (2) Yoga Loka will have no responsibility or liability for (a) any act or omission of any hotel, restaurant, carrier, or other third person or any such person's servants or employees; (b) any delays, missed planes or other carrier connection; (c) damage or injury to person, or loss of or damage or injury to, property; or (d) any defect or failure of any nature, however caused, of any product, machine or food. You promise not to make any claim against Yoga Loka related to any act or omission of any third person.

Yoga Loka also reserves, and you give it, the right to cancel further participation of any member of the party at any place, if Yoga Loka believes in good faith that the member's further participation in the trip may endanger him or others in any manner; or frustrate the purpose of the trip. You agree that Yoga Loka has no duty to provide you any medical care or treatment. You voluntarily assume the risk, known or unknown, of any activity being unsuitable for you medically, and of lack of medical attention at any time or place and for any reason. You will be financially responsible for any medical treatment and/or any costs of any emergency evacuation during the course of the trip, needed or advisable for yourself or any member of your family for any reason.

Any disputes of claims, which may arise relating to this contract or to events during the trip, will be settled by arbitration in the state of California. The law of the state of California will govern any contract disputes. Yoga Loka may make photographic, video, and/or audio records of this trip. You give Yoga Loka permission to make and to publish any such record for any purpose, private or commercial, without recourse and without compensation to you.
